

Dear RVRC Students

With the start of the new academic year (AY2017/18), the College is pleased to announce the inauguration of RVRC's two year academic programme that holistically develops Resilience, Respect and Responsibility in our students who aspire to be workplace ready and sustainability focused.

This paradigm shift in the academic programme has resulted in a significant change to the nature of student life in RVRC.

Prior to AY2017/18, RVRC's College Student Committee (CSC) was made up of residents in their first year of candidature. In view of RVRC's one year programme, the office bearing term of the CSC typically started in September of the first semester (after elections) and ended by the conclusion of the second semester (i.e. June/July period).

With effect from AY2017/18, RVRC will align the operational schedule of student life activities to its two year programme. Nominations and elections of every CSC office bearing term shall be held in March/April to prepare CSC members for starting their student leadership term in the following academic year (commencing July/August).

The 2nd CSC (Giles Ee Wei Sern, Ng Hao Yuan, Isabelle Anastasia Tan Yinn Lyn, Gary Heng Hui Shen, Jermayne Teo Xuan Minn, Wang Xiaodan, Gabriel Lye Jun Hui and Raelyn Lee Yi Ling) have fully completed their term in AY2016/17. This team had successfully contributed to a vibrant RVRC student life through the organisation or co-organisation of the following events: Inter House Game 2016, Supper Delivery, RVRC T-Shirt Design Competition, Welcome Back to School, CSC Dialogue session with students, Inter College Game 2017, RVRC Free Cone Day, Freshmen Orientation Camp AY17/18, Flag Day 2017.

The College would like to take this opportunity to appreciate the 2nd CSC for their student leadership efforts and their good works in RVRC.

Moving forward, the 3rd CSC shall be elected by March/April 2018. This brings about a transitional period for RVRC student life between now till the formation of 3rd CSC. As it is still the College's interest to ensure a vibrant student life for its community at large, we have formed the Student Life Protem Committee (SLPC) to assist the College in organising selected key college events within this short transitional period. The College encourages every resident to play an active part in RVRC's community, which includes contribution through SLPC.
